Pursuant to the Texas Radiation Control Act and Texas Department of State Health Services (Agency) regulations on radiation, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess and transfer radioactive material listed below; and to use such radioactive material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below. This license is subject to all applicable rules, regulations and orders of the Agency now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

- 10. The authorized place of use is at temporary sites, in areas <u>not</u> under exclusive Federal jurisdiction, throughout Texas.
- 11. Each site shall maintain documents and records pertinent to the operations at that site. Copies of all documents and records required by this license shall be maintained for agency review at Site 000.
- 12. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of 25 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §289.201, §289.202, §289.203, §289.204, §289.205, §289.251, §289.252, and §289.257.

- 13. Radioactive material shall be used by, or under the direct supervision of, individuals designated by the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) only after each worker has successfully completed a training course determined by the Agency as appropriate. Documentation verifying the successful completion of the training for each worker shall be maintained by the licensee for inspection by the Agency.
- 14. The individual designated to perform the functions of Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for activities covered by this license is Noel D. Smith.
- 15. Licensee is authorized to provide radioactive material storage service only for customers with a current radioactive material license. In addition to the procedures contained in the application dated December 14, 2014, the licensee shall make available for Agency inspection documentation verifying storage customer's license, storage agreement and radioactive material receipt and transfer records for material authorized by Parts F, I, and J of License Conditions 5, 6, 7 and 8.
- 16. Sealed sources containing radioactive material shall not be opened.
- 17. Tests for leakage and/or contamination may be performed at customer sites throughout Texas.
- 18. The licensee is authorized to distribute and analyze Leak Test Kit Test-1 and Leak Test Kit Test-2. The customer shall be provided a copy of the leak test results in terms of microcuries.
- 19. The licensee is authorized to perform the service of pocket dosimeter response checks in accordance with procedures received with application dated **December 14**, 2014.
- 20. The licensee is authorized to calibrate radiation survey instruments in accordance with procedures contained in application dated **December 14, 2014**.
- 21. The licensee is authorized to perform the service of alarming ratemeter calibration in accordance with procedures contained in application dated **December 14**, 2014.
- 22. The licensee shall conduct a physical inventory, at least every six months, to account for all sealed sources received and possessed under the license. The records of the inventories shall be maintained for inspection by the Agency for three years from the date of the inventory and shall include the radionuclide, number of curies, unique identifying number or serial number, location of each source of radiation, the name of the individual making the inventory, and the date of the inventory.
- 23. The licensee shall comply with the requirements described in U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Order EA-07-305 (the Order). Not-withstanding the time periods contained within the Order, the licensee shall comply with the following conditions in the time specified. The licensee shall complete implementation of said requirements by the first day that radionuclides in quantities of concern are possessed at or above the limits specified in "Table 1: Radionuclides of Concern" contained within the Order. The licensee shall notify DSHS Radioactive Material Licensing Group, Manager when they have achieved full compliance with the requirements described in the Order. The notification shall be made within thirty (30) days after full compliance has been achieved.

This notification shall include a certification that the Trustworthiness and Reliability (T&R) Official and any subsequent T&R Official, is themselves deemed trustworthy and reliable by the Licensee as required in B.2. of the Order. The licensee shall notify the Manager, Radioactive Material Licensing Group, DSHS at (512) 834-6688, ext. 2206 within 24 hours if the results from a criminal history records check indicate that an individual is identified on the FBI's Terrorist Screening Data Base.

24. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use the radioactive material authorized by this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in the following:

application dated December 14, 2014 and Business Information form dated December 14, 2014.

Title 25 TAC §289 shall prevail over statements contained in the above documents unless such statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
